Still active, still in use since mid 1970's, dump site encroaching on native allotment. Nightmute IGAP is monitoring dump site at 3 times a month since 2003. Site contained lead acid batteries, electronic wastes, waste oils, power line waste, animal waste, Freon waste, empty barrel drums.

Buildings on site: Nightmute airstrip about 3,000 feet away from the dump site. No building on dump site.

Approximate site size: *acres OR 700+ feet wide by 1,000 feet long*

General shape/size comments: New dump site created in the same location, waste were moved inland and contained in super sacks.
